At your visit you said to contact you when I ran out of equipment - what is the supply like? Do I need to have enough on hand for the whole season - or will I be able to get extra supplies quickly when this lot are starting to get low? You have converted me to your "shoe -shine" swabs of roundup - they're easy to carry, much less collateral damage, and uses less roundup. But can I have another one, as four hours for lopping today emptied one and I like to decanter my chemicals before I head off for the day.

I wrote on the work record before I thought to photocopy it - could I also have a fresh one of those.

Thank you once again for inspiring me to continue. I look forward to receiving the plant list from Andrew
